In the University Pathways Track in the Intensive English Program (IEP), students receive individualized support to transition successfully to a university or college. ILI partners with 12 carefully selected regional colleges and universities. **University Pathways Track IEP students who reach competency at level B2 do NOT need to submit a TOEFL iBT or IELTS score to our partner schools -- a University Pathways Recommendation from ILI satisfies our partner university's English requirements, thus exempting students from taking additional ESL exams.*

Five Graduate Credits are available through the World Learning SIT TESOL Certificate. Participants have the choice of whether or not to pursue graduate credit, but need to decide before the course begins. Regulations state that once the course has begun there is no reconsideration on the part of the World Learning SIT Graduate Institute Registrar's Office. Choosing the credit option means that the participant **will pay an additional \$500 fee directly to World Learning SIT, and upon successful completion of the course you will be awarded five graduate credits.*
