In the University Pathways Track in the Intensive English Program (IEP), students receive individualized support to transition successfully to a university or college. University Pathways Track IEP students who reach competency at level B2 do NOT need to submit a TOEFL iBT or IELTS score to our partner schools -- a University Pathways Recommendation from ILI satisfies our partner university's English requirements, thus exempting students from taking additional ESL exams.
